RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults – age 15 and above) Call the parish office for more information and registration for 2024-2025.

Everyone is invited to journey with our RCIA candidates in learning more about Catholic Faith. Catechesis is one of the pastoral priorities identified by our parish. The sessions are held on Monday evenings in the St. Agnes Hall. The sessions run from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Our next session is on **Monday, October 28, 2024**. The topic will be The Story of Salvation.

MARRIAGE: Because the church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of **six months notice prior to the intended date of their wedding**. Normally the parish boundaries determine in which parish marriage planning should take place.

FUNERAL: Family or designated person by the family should contact the Parish Office for funeral arrangements with the parish priest.

All parishioners are invited to attend Cor sessions on the Holy Eucharist, starting Nov 17th at St. Agnes after the noon Mass in the Merchant Hall. Format is a short presentation by Deacon Guy followed by small group discussions with separate men's and women's tables. Refreshments will be provided.


